Roots & Reefs: Restoring Resilience in North Sound

July 7–10, 2026

For Bitter End, the sea is not just scenery. It is the reason we are here. This July, we invite you to help protect it with us. Roots & Reefs places you alongside Bitter End's Marine Biologist in Residence, Dr. David Hudson, and visiting mangrove scientist Dr. Jason Krumholz for three days of hands-on restoration across the two living systems that keep North Sound resilient: the coral reefs offshore and the mangrove forests along our shores.

Explore mapped reef sites with our longtime dive partners at Sunchaser Scuba, see firsthand how coral spawns and recovers, then trade your fins or snorkel for a kayak paddle and plant young mangroves along North Sound's shoreline. Evenings begin with Cocktails and Conversation at the Quarterdeck Lounge and Library, where the science comes to life over a sundowner.

Locals are warmly invited. Each program can be joined on its own, so come for the full three days or choose the sessions that suit you.

Program Itinerary

Three days exploring North Sound's reefs, mangroves, and coastal ecosystems through guided adventures, hands-on conservation, and conversations with leading scientists who show how nature protects our shores.

Tuesday, July 7

5:30–7:00 PM **Cocktails & Conversation**
Open the series at The Quarterdeck Lounge & Library with Dr. David Hudson and Dr. Jason Krumholz. **Suggested donation \$20, includes a complimentary cocktail.**

Wednesday, July 8

7:30 AM **Reef Dive or Snorkel**
Explore North Sound's reefs alongside scientists and dive professionals. **Dive \$195, includes a \$30 donation. Snorkel: \$30 suggested donation.**

2:00 PM **Pour a Mangrove Planter**
A hands-on session building planters that protect young mangroves through their most vulnerable stage. **Suggested donation \$30.**

5:30–7:00 PM **Cocktails & Conversation**
Reconnect after a day in the field to talk through what you saw with the scientists. **Suggested donation \$20, includes a complimentary cocktail.**

Thursday, July 9

9:00 AM **Mangrove Paddle & Kayak**
Paddle the mangrove-lined waters of North Sound, one of the Caribbean's most vital coastal habitats. **Suggested donation \$30.**

Help restore Bitter End's coastline, planting red mangrove propagules where forests once thrived.

4:00–8:30 PM **Crepuscular & Early Night Dive**
A two-dive excursion watching the reef shift from day to night. **Dive \$195, suggested donation \$30.**
