55% waste diversion		We produced 1.6% less waste in 2024 in comparison with 2023 and 45% of the total 2024 waste was diverted from landfill. We can notice this is due to reduction of landscape, glass and food waste's – our food waste is given to pig farmers to serve as food to the animals, that is why we don't calculate carbon emissions of our food waste.
