

BAHAMAS REQUIREMENTS FOR BOATERS 2020

Boater Pre-Travel Requirements:

- **COVID-19 PCR Swab Test** results not more than 10 days old required for all international travelers to The Bahamas. This requirement will not end on July 1st.
- Children under the age of two are not required to have the test.
- Health form to fill out prior to travel https://travel.gov.bs/ including uploading test results.
 Users will receive immediate automated response with traveler's name and approval. Print response.
- Customs & Immigration Forms fill out and print prior to arrival

- Have copies of ALL forms, copy of passport and test results to present to Customs & Immigration upon arrival in The Bahamas.
- Marinas must be informed at least 48 hours prior to vessel's arrival.

Boaters Requirements once in The Bahamas

- On arrival (having cleared at local ports of entry), anyone disembarking at a marina will be subject to potential additional screening mandated by Ministry of Health, such as taking of temperature.
- While clearing Customs & Immigration, crew and passengers are required to wear a mask, covering the nose and mouth.
- There are no restrictions for inter-island travel within The Bahamas. Domestic travel needs to be logged in at https://travel.gov.bs/.

Please note: International commercial flights will be available starting July 1, 2020. Private aviation is permitted starting June 15, 2020.
