

ow, what a winter we have endured! This winter has been called a "generational winter" and has produced historically high levels of snow pack and rain. We saw storms dump inches of rain, and atmospheric rivers deluge the state of California. Luckily the vineyards were able to withstand all of this water, the soils are adequately filled for ample spring growth, and the salts have been leached from the root zone. Spring frosts are another worry, and we rely on wind machines and sprinklers to protect the tender new shoots with this year's growth from sub-freezing temperatures. The worst recent spring frosts in Santa Barbara County were in April of 2008 and 2011; we will hope with our fingers crossed that we avoid one in 2023.


We have been extremely busy in the winery with bottling the 2022 rosés and getting an early jump on the 2022 Santa Barbara County Chardonnay, which takes over a month to bottle. We also bottled the 2021 vineyard designated Pinot Noirs and 2020 Crockett. The 2021 Pinot Noirs have lower alcohols with higher acidities and

beautiful freshness. The 2020 Crockett is a rich, robust blend of Syrah and Petite Sirah from Rodney's Vineyard and was aged in barrel for over two years. I am very excited about these wines and hope you enjoy them!
