Wow, this year is flying by! I cannot believe it is already summer, and the year is half-way over. We had a very warm winter, which confused the vines and promoted very early bud-break and vigorous shoot growth about a month earlier than average! Frankly, I thought we would roll right through spring and into summer, but it cooled down and we even saw April and May rains. We had decent rainfall through winter and spring, which promoted healthy growth leading into summer. So far, summer has been warm but moderate and it looks like it could be an early harvest. The size of the crop looks average, but it is still too early to know what the quality of the vintage will be, fingers crossed it looks good!

In the winery, we have been busy racking barrels, putting together blends and bottling to open barrels for the coming vintage. Almost all the 2025 white wines have been bottled along with the 2025 Fesstivity sparkling wines that will undergo their secondary fermentation in bottle and rest on their lees for 2-5 years. We are also working on the 2024 Rhône varietal wines along with the 2025 Santa Rita Hills Pinot Noir. There is still a lot of work to be done leading up to harvest! We are looking forward to another beautiful year of wines from Fess Parker Winery!

Bottles placed in triage for a few years allowing the yeast to settle and the wine to mature.



Placing the crown cap before bottles are laid down in triage.

Before the crown cap is applied, a bidule (a small hollow stopper) is placed. This is positioned so that during riddling yeast sediment collects in the hollow cavity. They're removed during the disgorgement process.



In the cellar, we were hard at work bottling Anniversary Cuvée magnums. It's a very hands-on process.
