The full indoor-outdoor restaurant will feature a brightened sea-inspired color palette with an open-air setting and exposed interior kitchen. Immersive dining experiences will set the stage for memorable meals.

"Tanner's has been an institution among the Huntington Beach community for years and these forthcoming changes will take the culinary experience at Paséa Hotel & Spa to the next level," says **Paul Maddison, General Manager at Paséa Hotel & Spa**. "The hotel's new restaurant will be a destination in and of itself, serving as a favorite gathering space for hotel guests, locals and other Orange County visitors."

The renovations and new concept will be under the purview of Paséa's new Director of Food & Beverage Vincent Savignano. Before joining Paséa, Savignano oversaw the entire food and beverage operation at Estancia La Jolla Hotel & Spa as Director of Food and Beverage, following his three-year term as the hotel's Executive Chef.
