PROPERTY OVERVIEW

Location

Pueblo Bonito Vantage San Miguel de Allende is in one of the most beautiful and historic cities in Mexico. Recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site, this treasured city was awarded the distinction due to its cultural and architectural contribution to the Mexican Baroque and its importance in the struggle for the independence of Mexico from Spain.

A colonial-era city, San Miguel is in Mexico's central highlands and is known for its well-preserved, baroque Spanish architecture, thriving arts scene, and cultural festivals. The city was awarded the title of "World's Best City" by *Travel + Leisure* in its 2022 list of World's Best Awards.

The property is situated in the District Corazón (the Heart District), in front of the Zeferino Gutierrez Park. It is accessible by bus (both city and group tour) and is walking distance to downtown and the Parroquia de San Miguel Arcangel. The hotel features awe-inspiring views of the city's famous Church, the Parroquia, and the Convent of the Most Pure Conception (Las Monjas).

Description

The Pueblo Bonito Vantage San Miguel de Allende is designed with a residential feel, with hacienda-style buildings. The refined architectural style integrates the local environment, while respecting elements that are essential to guest relaxation and comfort. Multicolored, with a Moorish influence, beautiful fabrics, precious pieces, and details with the highest curation await guests and visitors, who will be completely enveloped by the hotel experience.

The hall and its spectacular gates create a "wow effect" with the spires of the iconic Parish of San Miguel Arcángel on the horizon.

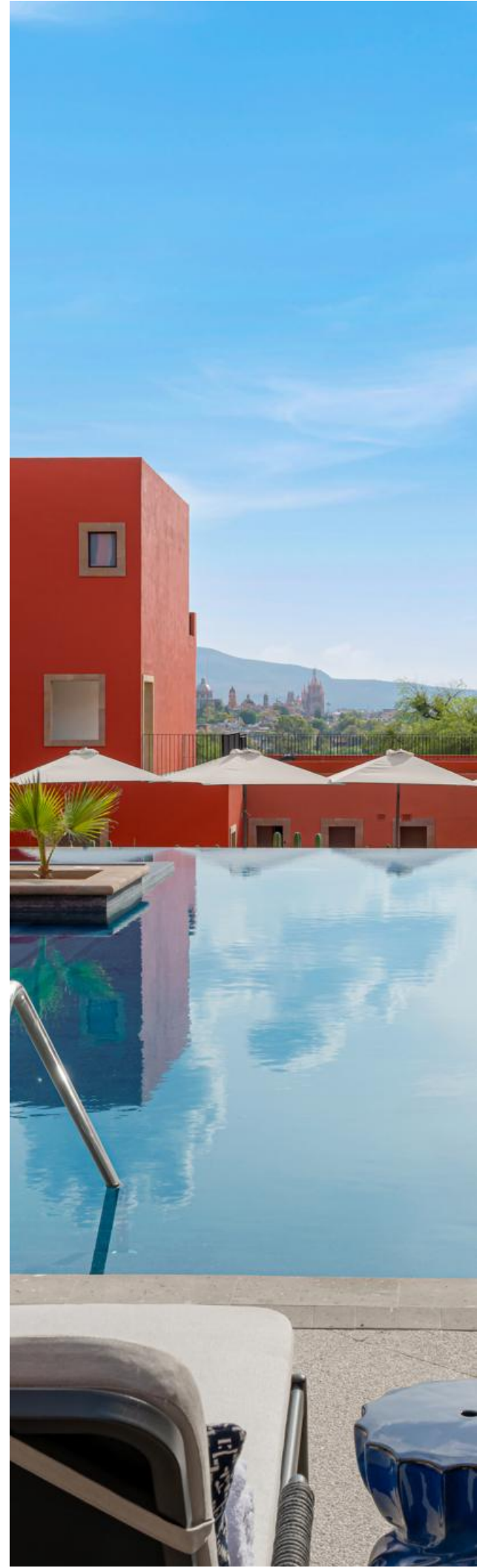

- Visit the temple and former convent of Jesús Nazareno (Santuario de Jesus Nazareno de Atotonilco), a revered historic site 15 minutes from hotel.
- Explore the pre-Columbian pyramids of the Cañada de la Virgen Archeological Site (a 2.5-hour drive from hotel)
- Tour in all-terrain vehicles (single, double and utility ATVs for 4 persons) along part of the original Independence Road between San Miguel de Allende and historic Dolores Hidalgo, with lunch in the mountains

Nature/Lifestyle

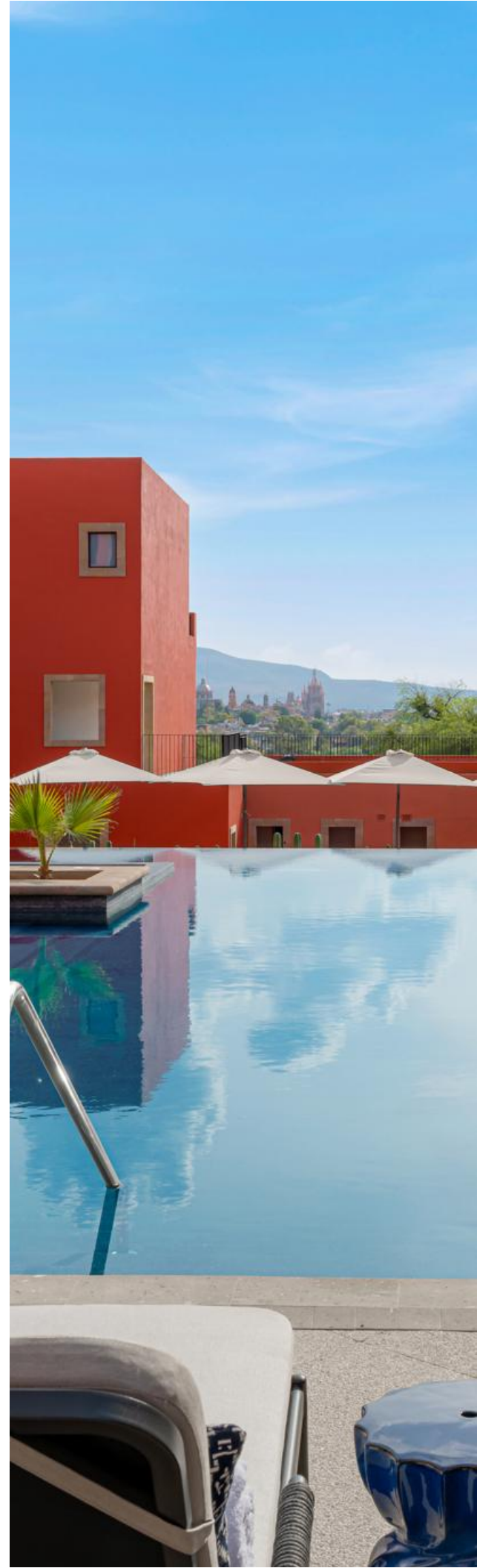
Enriching experiences help guests connect with nature and provide a sense of adventure:
