ABSINTHE FOUNTAIN

Step into the mystique of an era where absinthe was revered as the drink of poets, artists, and philosophers. The Absinthe Fountain, a true ritual of Parisian elegance, invites you to savor this iconic spirit in the most authentic way. With its delicate pour over caramelized sugar, balanced by a stream of ice-cold water, each sip unveils the complex flavors of this legendary libation.

La Fée Parisienne, France.....44

Based on the world’s oldest known absinthe recipe, La Fée is masterfully crafted using stills dating back to 1833. The Parisienne was the very first French absinthe released when the ban was lifted and to this day is the only absinthe to be authenticated by Marie-Claude Delahaye, founder and curator of the Museum of Absinthe in the South of France.

St. George Verte, California.....40

Founded in 1982 in Alameda, St. George is one of the oldest US craft spirits producers. After perfecting the recipe over 11 years while the sale of absinthe was banned but production was legal, St. George released the first legal American absinthe once the U.S. ban was lifted in 2007. St. George Absinthe Verte remains one of the most acclaimed and respected absinthes in the world.

Pernod Superieure, France.....54

Pernod Absinthe was created in 1805, in France’s first absinthe distillery. After years of being banned, its recipe was re-launched in 2013 based on the original formula. It includes anise, grand wormwood, petit wormwood, hyssop, and melissa, which provides anise, musk and herbaceous tasting notes. Pernod Absinthe contains no artificial dyes or sugar with the ideal serve being the traditional ritual of ice water cascading over a sugar cube.

Tempus Fugit Vieux Pontarlier, France48

Vieux Pontarlier is craft-distilled in Pontarlier, France; the historic “Capital of Absinthe.” Developed and made in one of the two last remaining absinthe distilleries still functioning in Pontarlier, using the distillery’s original, pre-ban logbook notes, and antique alembic stills designed specifically for making absinthe.
