The Role

The Electrician will report to the Supervisor and will be responsible for kitchen and gas equipment the operations, repair and maintenance of the Hotels electrical systems and equipment in accordance with established electrical codes and safety standards as well as assist with the promotion and implementation of energy efficiency standards.

Key duties and responsibilities:

- Perform daily inspection and maintenance of all kitchen equipment and other gas operated equipment as per manufacturer's recommendations and specifications.
- Perform routine maintenance of kitchen equipment and other gas operated equipment as per preventative maintenance schedule
- Work in conjunction with the food and beverage team and the Director of Food and Beverage and Culinary to address operational concerns on equipment that needs immediate action
- Work night shifts as necessary to carry out preventative maintenance of kitchen equipment and other gasoperated equipment
- Assist in the training of all operators of kitchen equipment regarding usage, cleaning and operating precautions to prevent injury to staff and damage to equipment
- Attend to emergency breakdown kitchen equipment and systems
- Effect proper installation of new or replacement equipment as instructed
- Work on requests submitted by other departments
- To assist with establishing a stock of spare parts and equipment necessary to carry out work
- To advise concerning major repairs/changes required
- To assist in other trade areas when instructed by a member of the supervisory team
- To comply with all instructions given by the Director of Maintenance and/or senior managers and supervisors
- To carry out assigned duties in respect of firefighting, fire protection and safety, and to be familiar with all firefighting equipment
- To carry out assigned duties in respect of disaster preparedness and response
- To leave all areas clean and tidy after work has been completed and return tools after use
- To cover shifts as and when necessary

- Knowledge of electrical safety standards, codes and practices
- Ability to troubleshoot and solve problems relating to a variety of electrical equipment and electric circuitry systems
- Ability to perform installation and servicing of various electrical equipment and systems
