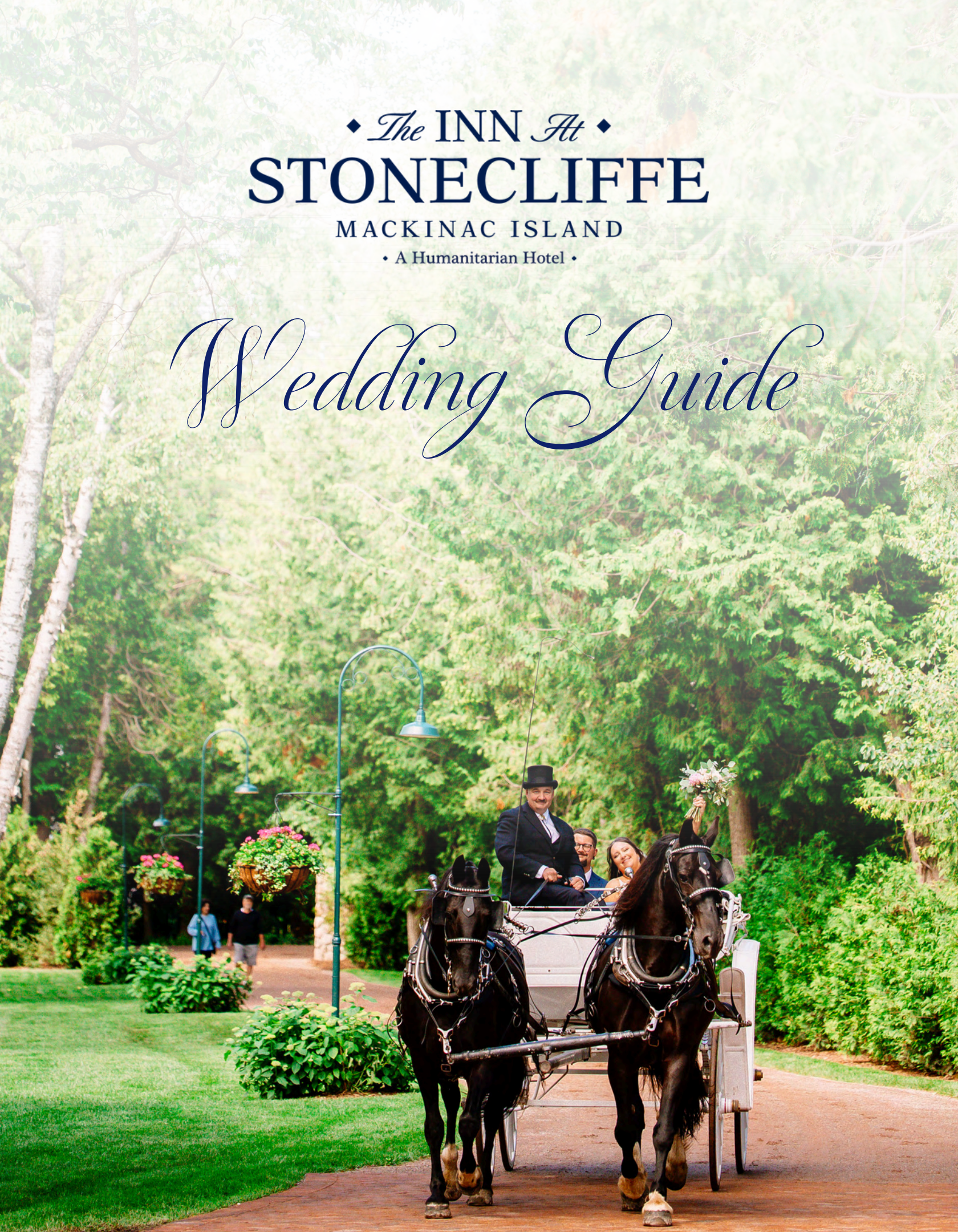

CONSULT BY PHONE

- Connect with the venue coordinator for a brief consultation to discuss your event wants, needs, style, scale, and budget.
- Receive an estimate of charges from the estimated guest count and based on information gathered. Please note the estimate of charges will remain "fluid" until we have absolute numbers from your final guest count and event design.

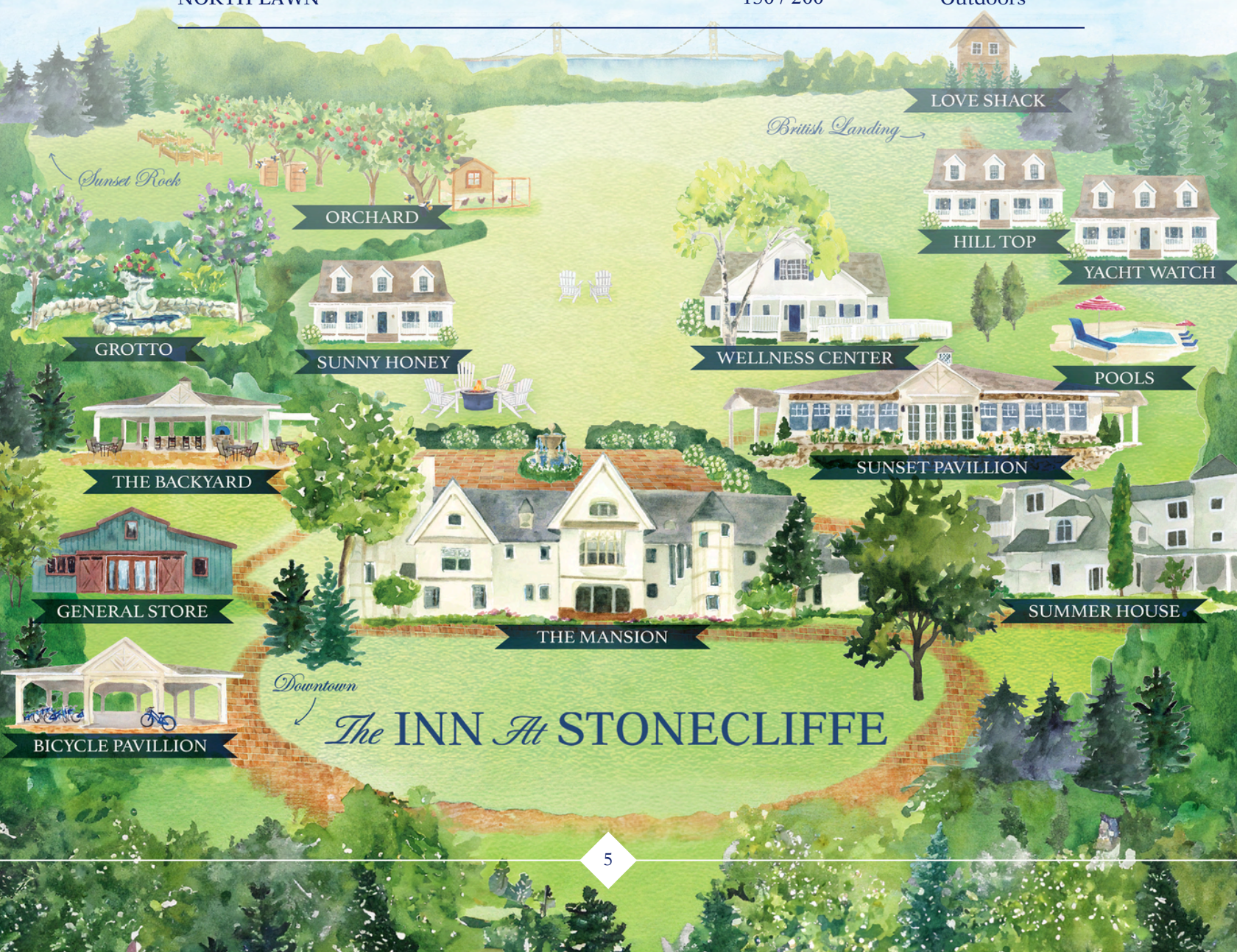

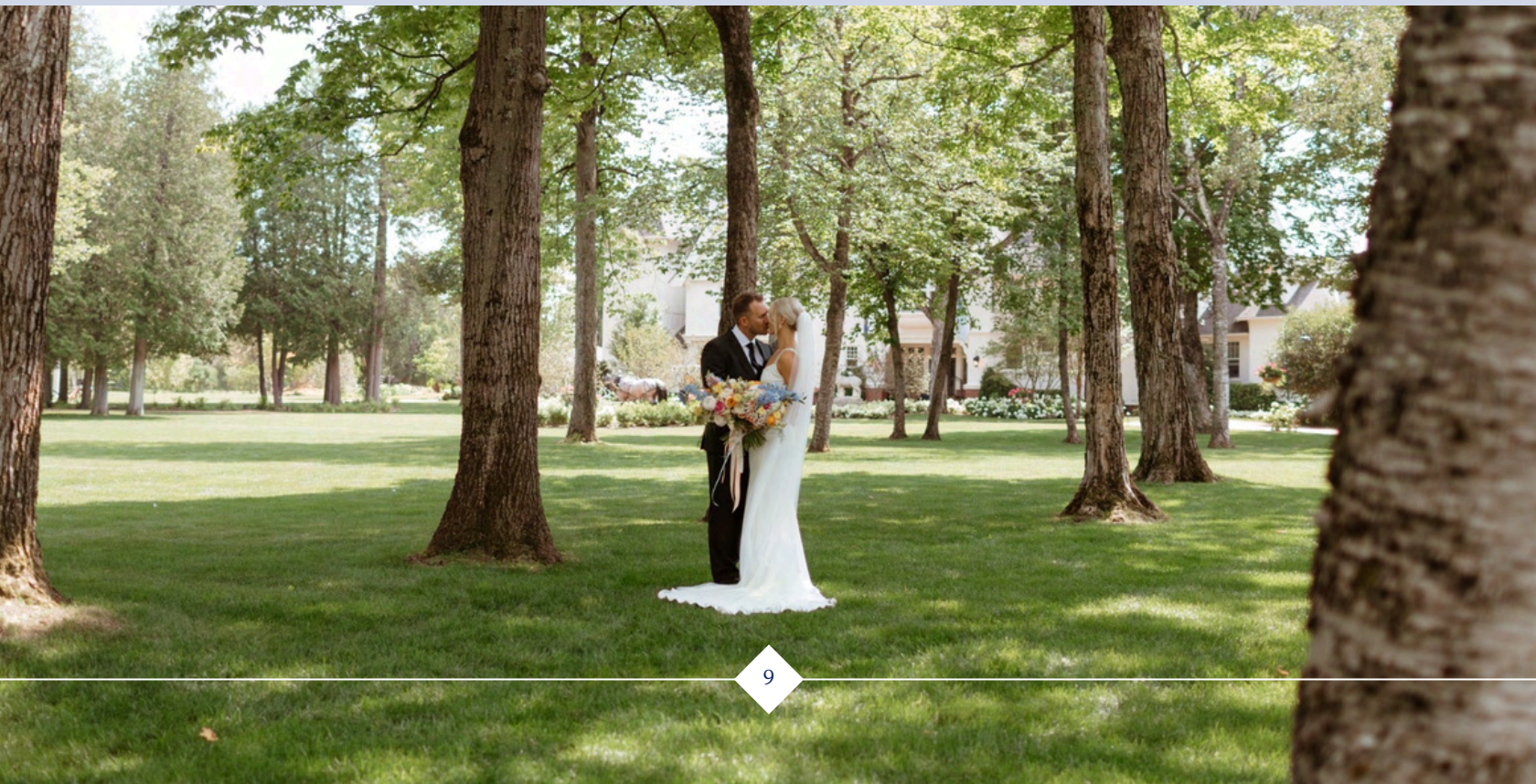

- Your food and beverage minimum does not include service charge, labor charges or sales tax.
- No leftover food except the wedding desserts are to be taken.

General Information

◆ FREIGHT INFORMATION

- All boxes incoming/outgoing should be coordinated in advance. Please use UPS.
- Please specify on the box the last names of the wedding couple and the Stonecliffe direct contact for ease of locating packages.
- Indicate each box as 1 of 5, 2 of 5, etc. so all boxes can be accounted for and stored together.
- Please ship items no more than 1 week prior to wedding date.

◆ TRANSPORTATION OF ITEMS

- When you arrive to the island, Please inform the Stonecliffe dock porter of the items that need to be delivered to Stonecliffe.
- If you transport items via passenger ferry, make sure you receive a Stonecliffe claim ticket for your items from the ferry staff.
- A dolly may be required for large items (boxes larger than 4'x 6'). The cost of the dolly will be determined by the Mackinac Island Service Company and will need to be paid for by the couple. The Service Company can be reached at 906.847.3713.
- Due to the demands of the dock porters, please note delivery of large items may be delayed.
- Gift bag room drop: \$12 per bag
- Any items taken back on the ferry must be notified 1 hour upon departure to ensure all luggage is tagged.

◆ EVENT REQUIREMENTS

At minimum a day of coordinator is required for your wedding

◆ UPLIGHTING PACKAGE

Event uplighting package pricing available upon request.

◆ CHARGES, TAXES, AND FEES

Taxes and Credit Card Fees:

- Food and beverage, event space, and services are subject to 6% state sales tax.

Service Charge:

- A 25% taxable service charge will be added to all events.

Labor Fees:

- Bartenders \$250 per bartender for up to 5 hours (1 bartender required for every 50 guests).
- Additional service staff beyond normal guidelines will be \$35 per hour per server.
- Private Security pricing available upon request.

◆ DEPOSITS & BILLING

- To secure your date, 25% is due upon signing.
- Payment in full is due 30 days prior to event, based on estimated minimum charges or current numbers, which ever is greater. Should your event go over the amount pre-paid, our finance department will charge the credit card on file the day after your event.
- A final copy of your bill will be sent within 1 week of your event completion.

Transportation

◆ FLYING IN

Many guests enjoy flying directly to Mackinac Island Airport. This is a small 3,500-foot lighted, paved runway capable of accommodating private and charter aircraft. Some guests fly to the larger airports and transfer to Fresh Air Aviation, operating out of St. Ignace.

Pellston Regional Airport (PLN) and Chippewa County International Airport (CIU) are the two closest commercial airports and are both 35 minutes from the ferry docks. Some guests find it more convenient to travel from Cherry Capital Airport (TVC), located about 2.5 hours south in Traverse City.

◆ FROM THE FERRY

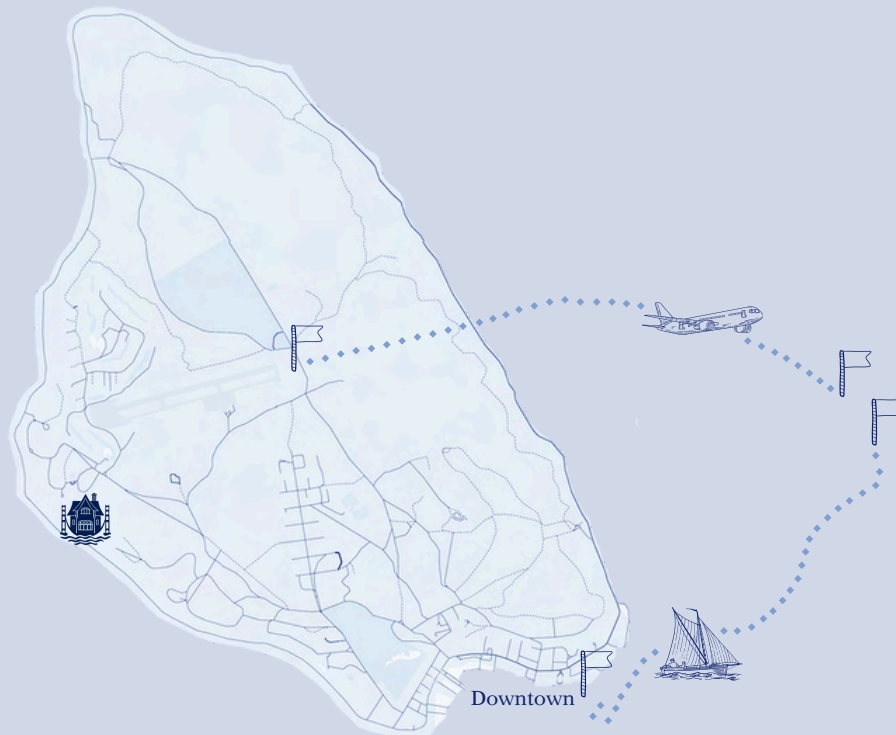
Park your car at the Shepler ferry dock in either Mackinaw City (south of the bridge) or St. Ignace (north of the bridge) and take a 16–18 minute ferry ride across the Straits of Mackinac. The ferry boats operate frequently throughout the day from May through the end of October. Parking options at the ferry dock depend on location. Luggage transfer is simple and convenient, with assistance on both the mainland and Mackinac Island. Please allow three hours for luggage transfer.

◆ PARKING

As you may know, cars are not allowed on the island. Ample parking is available at all mainland ferry docks. Rates depend on the company and parking location.

◆ TRANSPORTATION TO STONECLIFFE

Once you arrive on the island, enjoy our exclusive Stonecliffe horse-drawn carriage ride which leaves every hour on the hour from downtown up to The Inn at Stonecliffe.
